

Til' It Ain't ... Anymore

48 Count, 4 Wall, Intermediate, Waltz

Choreographer: Travis Taylor & Jan Wyllie (Aus) April 2014

Choreographed to: It Is What It Is by Kacey Musgraves.

Album: Same Trailer Different Park (Track 3:46 min)

Intro: 24 Counts

Waltz Back 1/4 L, Step Fwd, Tap, Kick, Waltz Back 1/2 L, Step Fwd, Full Turn L

- 1-2-3 Step back R, 1/4 L Step L together, Step R in place
4-5-6 Step L fwd, Tap R next to L, Kick R fwd

- 1-2-3 Step back R, 1/2 L Step L fwd, Step R slightly fwd
4-5-6 Step L fwd, 1/2 L Step R back, 1/2 L Step L fwd

Waltz Fwd, Step Back, Sweep, Right Sailor Waltz, Left Sailor Waltz

- 1-2-3 Step R fwd, Step L together, Step R in place
4-5-6 Step back on L whilst sweeping R around for Counts 5-6

- 1-2-3 Step R behind L, Step L to L side, Step R in place (R Sailor Waltz)
4-5-6 Step L behind R, Step R to R side, Step L in place (L Sailor Waltz)

Restart On Walls 3 & 6

Behind Side Cross, Step, Drag In, 1 1/4 R Roll, Step Fwd, Drag In

- 1-2-3 Step R behind L, Step L to L side, Cross R over L
4-5-6 Step L to L side whilst dragging R towards L for Counts 5-6

- 1-2-3 1/4 R Step R fwd, 1/2 R Step L back, 1/2 R Step R fwd
4-5-6 Step L fwd whilst dragging R towards L for Counts 5-6

Waltz Back 1/2 L, Step Pivot 1/2 L, Step Pivot 1/4 R, Step Fwd, Drag In

- 1-2-3 Step back R, 1/2 L Step L fwd, Step R slightly fwd
4-5-6 Step L fwd, Step R fwd, 1/2 L Pivot weight on L

- 1-2-3 Step R fwd, Step L fwd, 1/4 R Pivot weight on R
4-5-6 Step L fwd whilst dragging R towards L for Counts 5-6

Restart: During Walls 3 & 6, Restart after Count 24
