Intro 32 counts (from music)

# 1-8 Cross, side, behind, side, cross (moving to left), cross, side, behind, side, cross (moving to right)

- 1,2 cross right in front of left, step left to left side
- 3&4 step right behind left, step left to left side, cross right in front of left
- 5,6 cross left in front of right, step right to right side
- 7&8 step left behind right, step right to right side, cross left in front of right

### 9-16 Alternating cross steps (travelling backwards), and 4 steps

- 1&2& cross right in front of left, step back on left, step back on right, cross left in front of right
- 3&4& step back on right, step back on left, cross right in front of left, step back on left
- 5,6 step forward on right (with a hop), step forward on left
- 7,8 step forward on right, step forward on left (optional full turn to left)

## 17-24 Rock recover, right 1/2 shuffle turn, back 1/2 shuffle (turning to left), back rock recover

- 1,2 rock forward on right, recover onto left
- 3&4 right 1/4 turn stepping onto right, bring left beside right, right 1/4 turn stepping onto right
- 5&6 right 1/4 turn stepping onto left, bring right beside left, right 1/4 turn stepping back on left
- 7,8 step back on right, recover onto left

## 25-32 Cross shuffle to left, cross shuffle to right, jazz box 1/4 turn

- 1&2 cross right in front of left, bring left beside right, cross right in front of left,
- 3&4 cross left in front of right, bring right beside left, cross left in front of right,
- 5,6 cross right in front of left, step back on left
- 7,8 step forward on right making 1/4 turn to right, step forward on left

#### **Restarts:**

1st restart: Wall 3 after 16 counts 2nd restart: Wall 7 after 16 counts
