

Olde Song 32 Count, 4 Wall, Beginner

Vine right, touch, vine left, brush

- 1-4 Right step side; left behind; right step side; left touch by right
- 5-8 Left step side; right behind; left step side; right brush across left

Right cross-rock, left replace, right triple-step turn ¼ right, left step forward, right brush, hook, brush

- 1-2 Right cross-rock; left recover back preparing right turn
- 3&4 Triple-step turn ¼ right (RLR) (3:00)
- 5-6 Left step forward; right brush forward
- 7-8 Right hook back across left; right brush forward

"K" steps right forward & back obliques, right brush

- 1-2 Right step forward oblique; left touch together
- 3-4 Left replace back; right touch together ****
- 5-6 Right step back oblique; left touch together
- 7-8 Left replace forward; right brush forward **

Right rock forward, left replace, right triple-step turn 1/2 right, rock step, coaster step

- 1-2 Right rock forward; left recover back preparing right turn
- 3&4 Triple-step turn ½ right (RLR) (9:00)
- 5-6 Left rock forward; right replace back
- 7&8 Left step back; right together; left step forward
- ** **Restart** here on 5th wall (you will be facing 3:00)

**** Ending:

Turn ¼ left on count 3; right touch together on 4; step side on 5; hold 6

This is a very "old school / traditional" style country song with a swinging beat very much like the music from classic dances such as the Horseshoe, Drifter, or San Antonio Stroll from many years back. Very much an easy, country style dance.
