Position:Traditional Closed Position. Man faces LOD and Lady faces RLOD.
Partners on opposite footwork. Start dancing on lyrics

## MAN'S STEPS

TWINKLES
1-3 Cross right over left and step, step slightly to the left on left, step right together
4-6 Cross left over right and step, step slightly to the right on right, step left together
CROSS ROCK STEP, RECOVER, TOGETHER, FORWARD BASIC
7-9 Cross right over left and step, rock back to left in place, step right together
10-12 Stride left forward, step right together, step left forward
BACK BASIC, FORWARD BASIC
13-15 Stride right back, step left together, step right back
Raise man's left and lady's right hands. Lady turns under upraised joined hands
16 Stride left forward
17 Step right together
18 Step left forward step right back
Partners now in the right wrap position facing LOD
FORWARD BASIC, FORWARD BASIC
19-21 Stride right forward, step left together, step right forward
Raise man's left and lady's right hands. Lady turns under upraised joined hands
22 Stride left forward
23 Step right together
24 Step left forward
Partners now face each other in the double hand hold position. Man faces LOD and lady faces RLOD

## BACK BASIC, $1 / 2$ TO THE LEFT ROLLING TURN

25-27 Stride right back, step left together, step right back
Raise man's left and lady's right hands. Lady turns under upraised joined hands
28 Stride left forward and begin a $1 / 2$ to the left rolling turn
29 Step on right and complete $1 / 2$ to the left rolling turn
30 Step left together
Partners are now in the pretzel position. Man faces RLOD and lady faces LOD

## 3/4 TURN TO THE RIGHT WALK AROUND

During the next 6 counts partners will stay in the pretzel position while walking around in a circle making a $3 / 4$ turn to the right
31-33 Step slightly to the right on right, step left together, step slightly to the right on right
Partners have both made a $1 / 4$ turn to the right on these steps. Man facing ILOD and lady facing OLOD
34-36 Step slightly to the right on left, step slightly to the right on right, step slightly to the right on left
Partners have both made a $1 / 2$ turn to the right on these steps. Man facing OLOD and lady facing ILOD

## $1 / 4$ TURN TO THE RIGHT, BACK BASIC

Raise man's left and lady's right hands. Lady turns under upraised joined hands
37 Step a $1 / 4$ turn to the right on right
38 Step left together
39 Step right together
Partners now face each other in the double hand hold position.
Man faces RLOD and lady faces LOD. Man slightly to the right of lady
40-42 Stride left back, step right together, step left back

## $1 ⁄ 2$ TO THE LEFT ROLLING TURN, FORWARD BASIC

Release man's right and lady's left hands. Raise man's left and lady's right hands.
Lady turns under upraised joined hands...
43 Stride right forward and begin a $1 / 2$ to the left rolling turn
44 Step on left and complete $1 / 2$ to the left rolling turn
45 Step right back
Partners now in the single hand hold position. Man faces LOD and lady faces RLOD
46-48 Stride left forward, step right together, step left forward
Partners return to the traditional closed position
LADY'S STEPSTWINKLES
4-6 Cross right behind left and step, step slightly to the left on left, step right together
CROSS ROCK STEP, RECOVER, TOGETHER, BACK BASIC
7-9 Cross left behind right and step, rock forward to right in place, step left together
10-12 Stride right back, step left together, step right together
BACK BASIC, $1 ⁄ 2$ TO THE LEFT ROLLING TURN
13-15 Stride left back, step right together, step left back
Raise man's left and lady's right hands. Lady turns under upraised joined hands
16 Stride right forward and begin a $1 / 2$ to the left rolling turn
17-18 Step on left and complete $1 / 2$ to the left rolling turnPartners now in the right wrap position facing LOD
FORWARD BASIC, $1 ⁄ 2$ TO THE RIGHT ROLLING TURN
19-21 Stride left forward, step right together, step left forward
Raise man's left and lady's right hands. Lady turns under upraised joined hands
22 Stride right forward and begin a $1 / 2$ to the right rolling turn
23 Step on left and complete $1 / 2$ to the right rolling turn
24 Step right back
Partners now face each other in the double hand hold position. Man faces LOD and lady faces RLOD
BACK BASIC, ½ TO THE RIGHT ROLLING TURN
25-27 Stride left back, step right together, step left back
Raise man's left and lady's right hands. Lady turns under upraised joined hands
28 Stride right forward and begin a $1 / 2$ to the right rolling turn
29 Step on left and complete $1 / 2$ to the right rolling turn
30 Step right together
Partners are now in the pretzel position. Man faces RLOD and lady faces LOD

## 3/4 TURN TO THE RIGHT WALK AROUND

During the next 6 counts partners will stay in the pretzel position while walking around in a circle making a $3 / 4$ turn to the right
31-33 Step slightly to the right on left, step right together, step slightly to the right on left Partners have both made a $1 / 4$ turn to the right on these steps. Man facing ILOD and lady facing OLOD
34-36 Step slightly to the right on left, step slightly to the right on right, step slightly to the right on left Partners have both made a $1 / 2$ turn to the right on these steps. Man facing OLOD and lady facing ILOD

## 3/4 TO THE LEFT ROLLING TURN, BACK BASIC

Raise man's left and lady's right hands. Lady turns under upraised joined hands
37 Step to the left on left and begin a $3 / 4$ to the left rolling turn
38 Step on right and complete $3 / 4$ to the left rolling turn
39 Step left together
Partners now face each other in the double hand hold position.
Man faces RLOD and lady faces LOD. Man slightly to the right of lady
40-42 Stride right back, step left together, step right back

## $1 ⁄ 2$ TO THE RIGHT ROLLING TURN, BACK BASIC

Release man's right and lady's left hands. Raise man's left and lady's right hands. Lady turns under upraised joined hands
43 Stride left forward and begin a $1 / 2$ to the right rolling turn
44 Step on right and complete $1 / 2$ to the right rolling turn
45 Step left back
Partners now in the single hand hold position. Man faces LOD and lady faces RLOD
46-48 Stride right back, step left together, step right back
Partners return to the traditional closed position
