32 Count, 4 Wall, Intermediate

Intro: 16

**RIGHT ROCKING CHAIR, RIGHT FORWARD, TOGETHER, RIGHT FORWARD,
½ RIGHT TURN HITCH LEFT**

- 1-4 Rock right forward, recover to left, rock right back, recover to left
- 5-6 Step right forward, step left together
- 7-8 Step right forward, turn ½ right and hitch left

**LEFT FORWARD, RIGHT TOUCH, RIGHT BACK, LEFT HEEL, LEFT BACK COASTER,
RIGHT FORWARD, ¼ TURN LEFT**

- 1-4 Step left forward, touch right slightly back, step right back, touch left heel forward
- 5&6 Left coaster step
- 7-8 Step right forward, turn ¼ left (weight to left)

**RIGHT SIDE, LEFT TOGETHER, RIGHT SIDE, LEFT TOUCH, LEFT BEHIND, RIGHT SIDE,
LEFT CROSS, RIGHT SIDE, TURN ¼ LEFT FORWARD**

- 1-4 Step right side, step left together, step right side, touch left together
- 5&6 Behind-side-cross left-right-left
- 7-8 Step right side, turn ¼ left and step left forward

**RIGHT FORWARD, LEFT LOCK, RIGHT FORWARD, LEFT TOUCH, ¼ LEFT SAILOR,
RIGHT SIDE ROCK, LEFT RECOVER**

- 1-4 Step right forward, lock left behind, step right forward, touch left together
- 5&6 Left sailor step turning ¼ left
- 7-8 Rock right side, recover to left

TAG At the end of the 4th wall

CROSS ROCK, RECOVER, RIGHT SIDE CHASSÉ, CROSS ROCK, RECOVER, LEFT SIDE CHASSÉ

- 1-2 Cross/rock right over, recover to left
- 3&4 Chassé side right-left-right
- 5-6 Cross/rock left over, recover to right
- 7&8 Chassé side left-right-left

**¼ RIGHT FORWARD TOE STRUT, ¼ LEFT SIDE TOE STRUT, ¼ RIGHT FORWARD TOE STRUT,
¼ LEFT SIDE TOE STRUT**

- 1-2 Turn ¼ right and step right toe forward, lower right heel (3:00)
- 3-4 Turn ¼ left and step left toe side, lower left heel (6:00)
- 5-6 Turn ¼ right and step right toe forward, lower right heel (9:00)
- 7-8 Turn ¼ left and step left toe side, lower left heel (12:00)

ENDING Facing the 12:00 wall, replace steps 15-16 with rock right side, recover to left
