The ultra beginners are going to want to join the party as well and Cupid Shuffle fits perfectly to this funky track. If you want to spice things up a little, you can alternate one wall of Cupid Shuffle with another ultra beginner dance; I have been using my own 'Let's Chill' and it works very well.

Cupid Shuffle

4 WALL - 32 COUNTS - ABSOLUTE BEGINNER

Steps	Actual Footwork	Calling Suggestion	Direction
Section 1	Side, Together (x 3), Side, Touch		
1-2	Step right to right side. Step left beside right.	Side Together	Right
3-4	Step right to right side. Step left beside right.	Side Together	
5-6	Step right to right side. Step left beside right.	Side Together	
7-8	Step right to right side. Touch left beside right.	Side Touch	
Section 2	Side, Together (x 3). Side, Touch		
1-2	Step left to left side. Step right beside left.	Side Together	Left
3-4	Step left to left side. Step right beside left.	Side Together	
5-6	Step left to left side. Step right beside left.	Side Together	
7-8	Step left to left side. Touch right beside left.	Side Touch	
Section 3	Heel Touches/Kicks		
1-2	Touch right heel forward. Step right foot beside left.	Heel Together	On the spot
3-4	Touch left heel forward. Step left foot beside right.	Heel Together	
5-6	Touch right heel forward. Step right foot beside left.	Heel Together	
7-8	Touch left heel forward. Step left foot beside right.	Heel Together	
Note	Heel touches can be replaced by kicks if preferred.		
Section 4	1/4 Turn Left		
1-8	March in place for 8 counts, gradually making 1/4 turn to the left.	Turn	Turning left
Styling	Bend your knees and alternate knees apart/knees together on each step.		
	Or do whatever funky moves you can!
